Saturday 27th June 2009 - 'Rangers Ramble'

Elvetham Heath Local Nature Reserve.

Meet at 10:00am by the village pond, Elvetham Heath, just past Morrison's supermarket. (Grid ref. for meeting point SU 801554)

Join Tim Ackroyd, Elvetham Heath Ranger, on a walk at Elvetham Heath Local Nature Reserve to find out more about your local heathland, its history and how it is part of our heritage. The walk should take about one and a half-hours. If you have any binoculars please bring them with you. All abilities welcome. Suitable for wheelchair users.

Saturday 18th July 2009 – 'Dragons Damsels & Wild Flowers'

The walk should take about two hours. If you have any binoculars please bring them with you. All abilities welcome. Suitable for wheelchair users.

Wednesday 16th September 2009 – 'Bat Walk'

The walk should take about one to one and a half-hours, if you have a bat detector please bring it with you. All abilities welcome.
