Police Report

Dear All,

The Summer is now over and we are moving into the cooler Autumn months. I hope that you all had a chance to get away for a break and that you enjoyed what was in the main glorious weather. Over the Summer period we have been to several music events. Bands in the Bury at Odiham, Concert on the Heath on Elvetham Heath and finally Gig on the Green in Yateley were all on the same day. All were very well attended despite the extremely hot weather. The events were well run and all events arranged private security. Everyone seemed to be having a great time. As with all events there are some learning points for us and the organisers but, all in all, very successful. The recent Music on the Views was less fortunate weather-wise; however, well attended and I must confess to a bit of a "boogie" towards the end!

We were able to get out and visit some of the great events that have been put in place for the local children which were run by the Charity: Fleet Phoenix. These events took place all over Hart and were well attended. This meant that for at least one day a week the children had somewhere to go and have fun whilst their care givers hopefully had a little bit of respite.

We attended the Station Hotel public house where we invited members of the public to come and have a chat. The main reason for our visit was to discuss thefts from vehicles with the pub's customers. This was because of a recent customer whose van had been broken into. We had a number of people visit and were able to have a chat about a whole host of things. We are always looking for locations where we can meet you, so if you would like us to conduct an event like this at your venue please let us know.

Fleet police were also drafted in to assist Rushmoor with protests regarding the immigration hotel. Thankfully these protests passed peacefully, unlike some neighbouring police forces who have not been so fortunate.

August saw the Opening of a new Night Club in Fleet (same premises but different owners). This venue is called BUNKER. The owners liaised with me prior to opening. We were able to chat about our priorities which, as luck would have it, were aligned. We both want the venue to succeed but we are not willing to compromise when it comes to the safety of its customers and the wider community. The owners are collaborating and they will continue to work with us to ensure that Fleet Town Centre is a safe and vibrant place to come. The Night-time economy has had the boost it so desperately needed and I know that the other venues within the town centre will also continue to work with us and each other in order to achieve the same goals.

You may also have seen that we, together with many of our partner agencies, conducted an operation to tackle the ongoing issue of fly tipping. We were able to stop over 30 vehicles and dealt with numerous offences. Fly tipping is a blight to our streets and countryside which will not be tolerated. Hart District Council have a dedicated team that deal with this, so please report it to them. That was our Summer, but what else can you expect from us.

We have been liaising with the Church Crookham Parish Council, local schools and the gas company to look at the issue of the ongoing roadworks for the gas upgrade. We will be doing more soon, so watch this space.

We will be taking part in the Remembrance Sunday events on the 9th November in Fleet, Church Crookham and Odiham. We will be attending the Fleet festivities as we did last year. We will be looking out for those seeking to be anti-social, so if you see anything that night please let us know. We will be attending the Hart Youth Awards at the Harlington Centre. The Hampshire and the Isle of Wight Constabulary have sponsored one of the awards. This event celebrates some of the most amazing young people in our district. If last year is anything to go by, I would not want to be making the final decisions as to who should win. It is so nice to see that there are, despite some of the public opinions, so many gifted, thoughtful, caring and selfless young people in our community.

We are having a "Cops and Coffee" on the 11th December at 6pm in the Church Crookham Community Centre. If you are free please come and join us even if it is only for a coffee! For the rest of our time it is mostly business as usual. I would not want to spoil all the excitement by telling you everything that we are going to be doing, otherwise the next newsletter would be so boring!
