Police Report

I hope that you have all had a chance to read the previous report to know who I am and what we have been up to. I joined the team in April and I can say that Fleet and the surrounding towns and villages are a refreshing change. Crime affecting the wider public remains relatively low. This doesn't mean that I sit and drink tea in the office all day.

I have taken on the mantle of "Shoplifting" along with the tenacious PC Fitzgerald. You may have seen in the past few months that the Social Media posts have increased. We have been able to celebrate the incredible work of PC Fitzgerald with many of the local prolific shoplifters being given prison sentences. We have also been able to catch some criminals from the North who decided to do their yearly shop at Morrisons. With the help of a very astute member of the public, PC Fitzgerald's tenacity and the Cheshire Police's alertness we charged them with the shoplifting and sent them to prison within two weeks! Whilst it can't move that quickly every time, we are doing our best.

I have conducted an operation within Fleet Town Centre to visit the local pubs and its customers to see if they had any drug issues. There is a growing trend of people drinking and taking drugs in order to enjoy a night out. I wanted to see if this problem or trend was prevalent in Fleet. We were joined by the dog section who brought a drug detection dog. You will be pleased to read that all the pubs we visited welcomed our presence and were in fact requesting that we do it more often! You will be even more pleased to note that whilst we did find some drugs, there was no indication that this was a major issue within these establishments. I am hoping that this will send a message to the public that we will not tolerate drugs in our pubs and clubs.

We are tackling the ongoing issue of Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB) within the district. We have not had a repeat of last year within the Town Centre; however, we do not kid ourselves that we have solved the problem and are forever vigilant that it does not repeat itself. I am very lucky that within Hart we have some very excellent partnerships to assist us. We rely heavily on the Hart Community Safety Team. They assist us with the ASB. They attend the schools and work with them, as well as visiting the communities where ASB has been identified and work with them too. They can be contacted direct if you feel that any issues are community issues that they can help with. I would urge you to report any ASB either to us or to Hart Council. Please don't wait for the problem to become too much, report it.

Another partner we work with is Fleet Phoenix. They provide invaluable support to young people. This included putting on an activity for them every day during the summer holidays which is no mean feat I can tell you! We are able to share information and give guidance and help where it is needed. It is essential to work with them and the young people.

It has also been my pleasure to witness the "Concert on the Green" on Elvetham Heath and the "Music on the Views" events as well as the Fleet Christmas festivities. I attended all these events and it was lovely to see and talk to those in attendance. The events were quite large with hundreds of people revelling in outdoor concerts and the Christmas stalls. The organisers were very experienced and they all went without a hitch.

My message to you all is that you live in a lovely area and I am pleased to be here to assist you. But I would just say that I cannot help you if you do not report it. The local team, whilst small in size and often diverted to work elsewhere, are big in heart. We are doing everything we can to make your communities safer but we are not "mind readers". Please tell us about it, or our partners, and we will try to help. If it doesn't "look right" then it probably isn't. You can be and are our "eyes and ears".

Some problems may not be a matter for the police and I would urge you to look to our partners for assistance as they are more likely to be able to assist with the time required to help.

Lastly, please do read the information on the Hampshire Constabulary website and the Neighbourhood Watch website. There is some invaluable help to avoid being a victim whether it be a "scam" or a "burglary". They have plenty of tips and hints to help minimise the likelihood of becoming a victim. If you do become a victim, please report it to us and we will support you.
